- Further the development of




#### **Our Research Aims**


- Build the evidence base for permaculture

### Research Protocols: concept

- To address the lack of systematic documentation, we have proposed:
  - A system for local monitoring of projects
  - That can be aggregated
  - Using 'farmer friendly' methods
  - That enable local learning
  - And can be incorporated into the permaculture design process







### Research Protocols: progress

- Initial work: identify tests for soil and biodiversity
- Testing: UK and internationally
- Funder: Lush Cosmetics
- Partners: Garden Africa, Coventry University's Centre for Agroecology and Food Security. More welcome.
