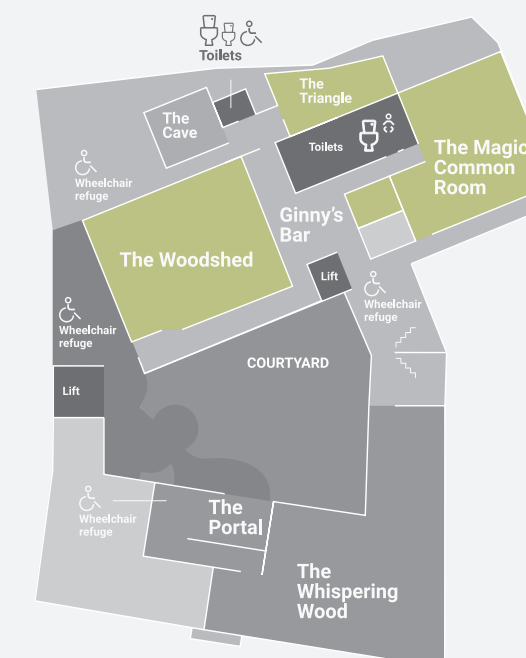

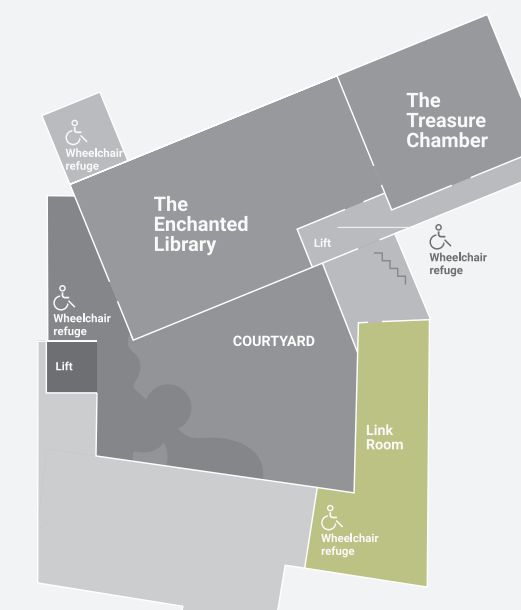

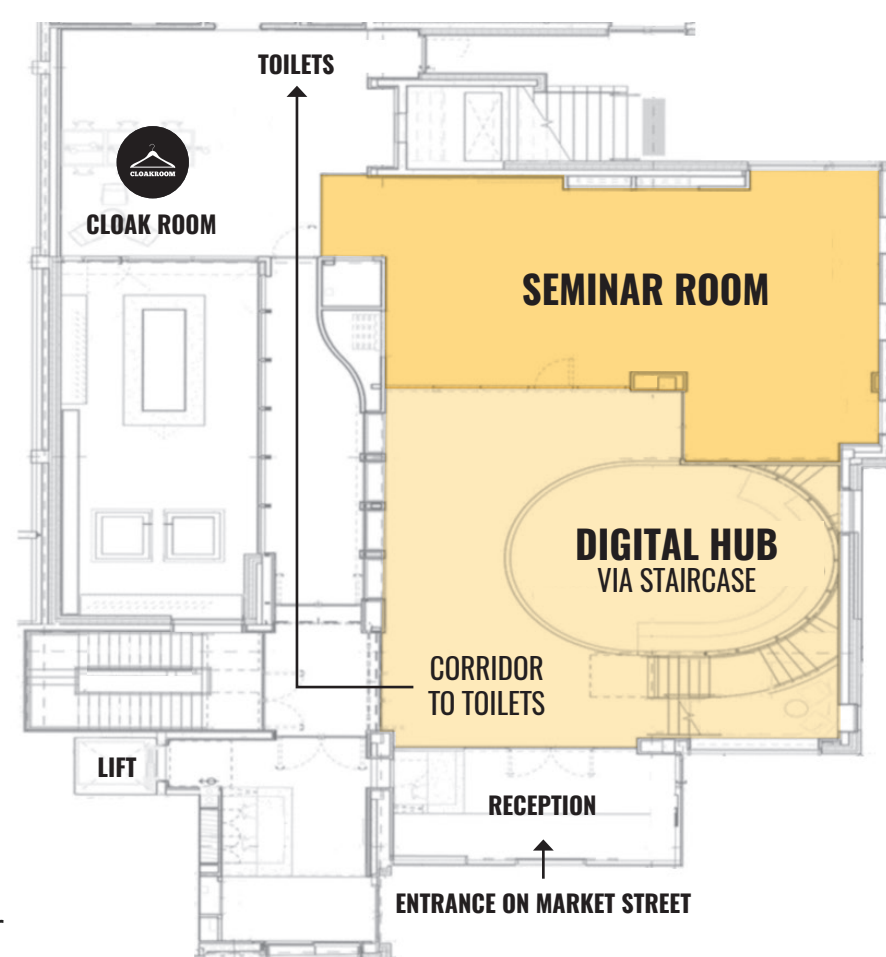
FIRST FLOOR

LOCAL RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FOOD AND DRINKS

Coffee

Colombia Coffee Roasters: single origin coffees, freshly roasted
Jericho Coffee Traders: ethically-sourced, small batch coffee roastery
Missing Bean: espresso bar serving sandwiches and pastries

Cafés

Yellow Submarine Café: quality sandwiches and coffee
Vaults & Garden Cafe: organic, ecologically minded cafe in a beautiful venue
The Handle Bar: breakfasts, lunches and dinners sourced from independent local suppliers

Restaurants

OFS x Damascus Rose: Middle-Eastern food from a social enterprise supporting refugee women in the city
Lula's Ethiopian: authentic Ethiopian and Eritrean dishes

Hamblin Snack Bar: quality sandwiches on stoneground heritage sourdough
Chickpea: vegetarian falafel restaurant

Pubs

The Royal Blenheim: real ale from a local brewery, plus pub meals
St Aldates Tavern, Turf Tavern and Kings Arms: all traditional pubs with real ale, craft beer and meals.
